- Everything sold, given away, or distributed must be vegan.
- Participants do not need to be vegan; anyone can join in.
- If you can't hold a bake sale during the "official" period, that's ok – really, any time is fine. Some 2009 bake sales were in August and September.

Participants in 2009 included a City Council member, a pre-school, a sci-fi convention, a student environmental coalition, vegan entrepreneurs, well-known animal protection organizations such as Farm Sanctuary and Compassion Over Killing, and groups of friends who simply wanted to give the public a chance to try delicious vegan baked goods.

Proceeds from various bake sales – on four continents – went to river cleanup efforts, a children's shelter, anti-discrimination programs, local humane societies and spay/neuter services, vegan advocacy groups, and farm animal sanctuaries.
